



How do I prepare for treatment?

1. Vacuum interior as thoroughly as possible prior to treatment. (Vibration will help flea eggs to hatch).
2. Be sure to flea dip your pests prior to treatment and as close to actual treatment as possible.
3. Remove all items (clothing, toys, magazines, etc.) from floor, under beds, and under furniture.
4. All pests (reptiles, birds, fish, etc...) need to be removed from home for approximately 4-6 hours after treatment.
 - a.) Fish may remain, only if tank pump is turned off and a plastic bag is taped to cover top of tank.
5. All persons should not re-enter home for approximately 4-6 hours or until carpet is completely dry.
6. If exterior foundation and lawn area are to be treated, the lawn should be freshly mowed and no longer than 3" in length, and completely trimmed around foundation, fences, shrubs, trees, etc.

What should I expect after treatment?

1. You may experience live fleas for up to 2 weeks after the treatment, this is normal. Flea eggs may take 7-14 days to hatch, we can not prevent the eggs from hatching, they must hatch and come into contact with the treated surface. We have applied a "Growth Regulator" to halt the production of more fleas, but the existing eggs must hatch.

To help maximize your treatment and reduce the activity sooner, **you must vacuum daily** and place vacuum bag in a sealed container outside of the home.
